John will impart his knowledge on caving and he and Lori Dunn will help members find and identify some of its inhabitants; particularly several species of salamanders, bats, cave crickets and also snakes and other amphibians to be discovered on the grounds. Of course there will be lots of birding opportunity as well! This will be a relaxed, fun outing and a chance to get to know some of nature's tiny inhabitants (we do not mean Lori haha!)
